

Position Title: Campus Facilities & Maintenance Coordinator

Hours/week: 40+ (full-time)

Reports To: Campus Pastor and Facilities & Maintenance Director

Classification: Salaried/exempt

Pay Range: \$43,000 - \$50,000, depending on experience

This staff position is essential in the ministry of Woodmen Valley Chapel (Woodmen) to spread the gospel and expand God's kingdom by gathering, connecting, growing and contributing. The individual in this role is to fulfill the following responsibilities in such a way as to demonstrate and live out Woodmen's vision to love well and change lives through Christ.

PRIMARY RESPONSIBILITIES:

- 1. Accountable for assuring daily setup of facilities as scheduled
- 2. Stays alert to security and safety procedures/concerns and addresses issues immediately
- 3. Responsible for the security of the campus, making sure facilities are locked when not in use
- 4. Responsible for maintaining operational condition of all facilities-related equipment
- 5. Maintains current and accurate drawings for each campus
- 6. Ensures Quality Assurance of vendors' performance
- 7. Cleans up as required during work performance
- 8. Supervises use of Woodmen vehicles
- 9. Maintains National Institute for Occupational Safety and Health (NIOSH) standards and Material Safety Data Sheets (MSDS)
- 10. Other duties as assigned

SKILL/ABILITY/KNOWLEDGE REQUIREMENTS

- 1. An ongoing relationship with Jesus Christ demonstrated by regular prayer, Bible study, and worship attendance.
- 2. A regular attendee and Commissioned Leader of Woodmen who supports the church vision and values, as well as contributes time and tithes and adheres to Woodmen's Statement of Faith and all policy and belief documents
- 3. Associates degree from a 2-year college in a related technical field or a certificate or diploma from a trade school in a related field, preferred
- 4. Five years' experience supervising the maintenance and operation of an office/convention facility and its staff
- 5. Ability to work with a diverse group of professionals in a Christian environment
- 6. Ability to carry out performance of tasks with a servant's heart
- 7. Experience with repairs and maintenance of a variety of equipment
- 8. Knowledge and experience in project management, minor construction and development of plans
- 9. Knowledge of and experience with OSHA standards and MSDS
- 10. Knowledge and experience with NIOSH and industrial safety practices
- 11. Ability to operate commercial powered equipment, automobiles and trucks (standard and automatic)
- 12. Ability to lift and carry up to 50 pounds (i.e., equipment, office supplies, yard equipment)
- 13. Must be able to stand for several hours, withstand cold and heat, and walk a distance of one mile
- 14. Must be able to work in and around facilities, storerooms and maintenance areas in confined spaces and be able to climb heights up to 50 feet
- 15. Must have a valid Colorado Driver License and reliable transportation
