This staff position is essential in the ministry of Woodmen Valley Chapel (Woodmen) to spread the gospel and expand God's kingdom by gathering, connecting, growing and contributing. The individual in this role is to fulfill the following responsibilities in such a way as to demonstrate and live out Woodmen's vision to love well and change lives through Christ.

PRIMARY RESPONSIBILITIES:

- 1. Oversees all aspects of Elementary Ministries/AWANA and ensures consistent quality at each service time for Elementary Ministries
- 2. Builds community with RR Elementary and AWANA families
- 3. Part of Woodmen Kids team, initiating/implementing ideas/updating programs; participates with program/event development
- 4. Part of RR Campus team, initiating/implementing ideas/updating programs; participates with program/event development
- 5. Coordinates with Access (special needs) Ministries on the RR Campus
- 6. Provides administration for weekend services/AWANA (including attendance and communication with families)
- 7. Oversees teaching on weekends and at AWANA; assists with teaching supplemental/special classes as needed
- 8. Oversees recruiting and onboarding of RR Elementary Kids MPs
- 9. In charge of developing and maintaining a volunteer team to help assemble curriculum crates
- 10. Works with Facilities Team to ensure facilities are safe for children
- 11. Mandatory reporter/advocate for children; keeps Director and Pastor informed of situation(s)
- 12. Maintains specified, yet flexible weekly office hours
- 13. Other duties as assigned
