

OCTOBER FAMILY GUIDE BABIES & TODDLERS

SEPT 30 & OCT 1 THE STORY OF JOB (JOB 1-3)

BIG IDEA: Job was a good man who loved God. He experienced a lot of hard things, but he continued to trust that God was in control of his life, and we can trust in that, too!

GOD IS IN CONTROL

OCTOBER 14 & 15 SODOM AND GOMORRAH (GENESIS 19:12-28; 2 PETER 2:6-10)

BIG IDEA: God destroyed the sinful cities of Sodom and Gomorrah. Because He is righteous, God cannot be a part of sin. We sin, too, but God forgives our sins through Jesus and loves us still!

GOD IS RIGHTEOUS

OCTOBER 7 & 8 ABRAM AND GOD'S PROMISE (GENESIS 12:1-5, 17:1,7)

BIG IDEA: God promised Abram that he would have many children. Abram waited many years for this promise to be fulfilled, and God was faithful and blessed him with a son.

GOD IS FAITHFUL

OCTOBER 21 & 22 / 28 & 29

ISAAC & REBEKAH / MOSES & THE TEN COMMANDMENTS (GENESIS 24 / EXODUS 20)

BIG IDEA: God kept His promise to Abraham and provided a wife for his son, Isaac. God took care of his people, the Israelites, by providing laws to guide their choices. God gives us the Bible so we have Him as our guide, too!

GOD STATEMENT: God Has A Plan



MORNING TIME:
