

MAKE: Detective for God's Path

Help each baby create a memorable craft for a loved one

SUPPLIES:

card brown stamp pad black sharpie



DIRECTIONS:

Gently press the baby's hand into the stamp pad, then press it onto the center of the page with fingers pointing downward to create a "clue print." At the top of the page, fill in the blank with the baby's name on the dotted line: Detective .

SAY:

"Look at your handprint! It's a clue that God is your Creator. God gives us clues in His Word and leads us every day."

BLESSING: May you follow Him always and walk in the path He sets for you. God is our Leader!

PLAY: Crossing the Jordan!

SUPPLIES: blue poster and footprint stickers

DIRECTIONS:

Lay the baby on a mat or hold them in your lap. Place the blue "river" poster in front of them. For younger babies, have them crawl across the river.

For Older babies, Offer them one sticker at a time and gently guide their hand to place it on the "river." Stickers can form a little trail across. Cheer and encourage as they place each sticker!

SAY:

"You're placing the sticker just right, Detective! God had a plan to help His people cross the big river, and He has a special plan for your life too. You can always trust God to lead you!"

PLAY: Find the Bible Clue!

SUPPLIES: baby blanket, small bible toy and footprint

DIRECTIONS:

Gently hide the Bible object under the blanket. Let baby explore by lifting the blanket or helping you reveal what's underneath. Repeat a few times, using soft excitement and smiles as you "find the clue!"

SAY:

"Peek-a-boo! You found the Bible clue! God gave us the Bible to help lead us. Just like a detective finds clues, we can find God's truth and plan in His Word!"
