LESSON GOAL:

For kids to understand that God made them and loves them!

STORY:

God Made You Just Right
by Jill Roman Lord

*Read the book provided
in the curriculum bag*

KEY VERSE:

*You created the
deepest parts of my
being. You put me
together inside my
mother's body.*

Psalm 139:13

WORSHIP

Introduce the value of singing and praising God by singing these songs together or over the kids in your class.



SAY:

God is worthy of our praise! Let's sing and dance and praise Him together!



DO:

Use instruments or simple hand motions to help kids engage further.

GOD MADE ME



MAKE: God Made Me - Take Home Mirror

Help enforce the lesson in a tangible way by helping create this take home item

SUPPLIES:

- Handheld mirrors
- "God Made Me" labels
- Activity card
- Small bags



DIRECTIONS:

Find a clear space to work with each child individually and prepare all your materials before you begin.

Adhere the "God Made Me" label on the outside of the mirror. Show the mirror to the baby and say, "God made you and God loves you!" Place the mirror and activity card in the small organza bag and tighten the strings.

Place the craft in a safe place (out of reach from children) until parents come to pick up.



ACTIVITY:

God Made Me - Mirror Play

SUPPLIES: *Small handheld mirrors
(from "Make" activity)*

DIRECTIONS:

Sit on the floor with one child or a group of children. Let the child(ren) explore the mirror and their reflection in the mirror. As they look at themselves, point to different parts of their body and say, "God made your (eyes)" or "God made your (ears)"

SAY:

God made you (insert child's name)! He made your eyes, your ears, your nose, your toes. God made you and He loves you!



ACTIVITY:

Peek-a-boo God Made You!

SUPPLIES: *Small blanket, burp cloth,
etc. (in your classroom).*

DIRECTIONS:

Sit on the floor with one child or a group of children. Use a small blanket, burp cloth or even a towel to play peek a boo. Cover your face for a moment then uncover it and say "peek-a-boo, God made you!" and "peek-a-boo, God loves you!"
