BIBLE STORY

READ: God's People Become Great
The Big Picture Story Bible, pg. 103

EXPLORE ACTIVITIES

Use these activities to relate to this month's God statement and play with the children

Walk the River Maze

Use light-weight blue scarves to make a river maze on the floor. Have the children follow the maze to the end. They can tip-toe, crawl, hop, etc.

SAY: "Remember, when Moses was a baby, he floated on the river. God protected him and kept him safe. He is our protector."

Baby Moses Match

Use the baby Moses pieces for a color matching activity. Match the baby to the basket.

SAY: "Moses was a baby just like you. Look how He used Moses to free His people. God had a plan to protect the Israelites and He has a plan for you."

Peel the Leaves

Tape the contact paper sheet to the wall (sticky side out). Place foam leaves on the sticky part. Encourage the children to remove and re-stick the leaves.

SAY: "When Moses grew up, God spoke to him through a bush that was on fire. Take the leaves off the wall and put them back on. The leaves look red like fire. God used the burning bush to speak to Moses. God used Moses to free the people of Israel. Can we free the leaves from the wall?"

Baby Moses

Lay out blue play scarves for water and have the children swaddle a baby doll in a blanket. Use a toy bucket as a basket and place the swaddled baby inside. Then, encourage them to gently push the basket around,

SAY: "Look how gentle you are pushing the baby in the water. Keep the baby safe just as God kept Moses safe."

KEEPSAKE

Help each baby create a memorable craft for a loved one.

MAKE: Photo Frame

Supplies: Stamp pad, photo frame

Directions: Use stamp pads to apply the child's fingerprints to the sides of the photo frame. Place the child's picture in the center of the frame.

SAY: "Look at your fingerprint and your picture. Remember, God made you in His image; you are His creation! Just as He had a plan for Moses, He has a plan for you. May God keep and protect you always!"
