GOD HAS A PLAN

LESSON GOAL:

For kids to understand that God is in charge of everything and He has a plan for each of us!

BIBLE STORY:

King David

Read the printed story in your curriculum bag

KEY VERSE:

The Lord has set up his throne in heaven. His kingdom rules over all.

PSALM 103:19 (NIRV)

WORSHIP

Introduce the value of singing and praising God by singing these songs together or over the kids in your class.

SAY:

God is worthy of our praise! Let's sing and dance and praise Him together!



DO:

Use instruments or simple hand motions to help kids engage further.

MAKE: God Has a Plan for Me Magnet

Help each baby create a memorable craft to remember the lesson

SUPPLIES:

- God Has a Plan picture frame card
- Double stick tape
- Photo printer
- Sticker Magnet



DIRECTIONS:

Work with your Woodmen Kids Coordinator to take pictures of each child in your class and print them on the photo printer. Once printed, use double sided stick tape to adhere the picture in the center of the picture frame. Adhere the sticker magnet to the back of the frame.

SAY:

"Little you, bright as can be—God has a plan made just for thee. Each day you grow and learn His way, held in His love as you laugh and play."

ACTIVITY:

Mirror Play

SUPPLIES:

Small shatterproof mirror

DIRECTIONS:

Sit on the floor with one child or a group of children. Use the mirror to show the child(ren) their reflection. Spend time talking about each child and how God made them and God has a purpose for them. For older babies, allow them to hold the mirror and explore more reflections.

SAY:

"Look in the mirror - that's you! God made you. God loves you. God has a purpose for you."

ACTIVITY:

Following God's Plan

SUPPLIES:

Velcro footprints

DIRECTIONS:

Adhere the velcro footprints in a line making a path. Encourage the kids to crawl or walk along the path. For younger babies, you can carry them along the path as you talk about God's plans.

SAY:

"God has a plan for each of us. We are walking on this path like the way we follow God!"
