BLESSING

EXPLORE ACTIVITIES

Use these activities to relate to this month's God statement and play with the children

Roll the Die Movement

"Let the children take turns rolling the die (or have a leader do it) and guide them in acting out the motions of what is listed on the die."

SAY: "Okay we are going to (read the motion). You moved like _____. Did you know that _____ is part of the story of how Jesus came to be? God sent Jesus to be our Savior."

Nativity Playset

Lay the nativity set out and let the children hold and explore the pieces. If children are willing, explain who each piece represents. You can even narrate the story using the pieces.

SAY: "Wow you are holding baby Jesus. God sent Jesus into the world to be our Savior!"

Pin the Star above the Barn

Tape the manger scene to the wall. Give each child a star and have them take turns placing it above the scene. They can do this as many times as desired.

SAY: "Look at the star. It guided the wisemen to find where Jesus was. They brought Him gifts. They knew He was sent to be our Savior."

KEEPSAKE

Help each baby create a memorable craft for a loved one

MAKE: Handprint Star

Supplies: Stamp pad, Card

Directions: Place the child's hand in the yellow stamp pad. Place their hand in the middle of the light beams. Wipe child's hand off.

SAY: "Look at your handprint. Remember, God made you in His image; you are His creation! Jesus came down as baby just like you to be our Savior."
