BIBLE STORY:

MAKE: Heart Footprint Keepsake

Help each baby create a memorable craft for a loved one

SUPPLIES:

Red paint Paint brush Heart card Wet wipes



DIRECTIONS:

Gather all supplies and find a clear space to do the craft with one child at a time. Remove the child's socks/shoes. Gently paint the bottom of one foot and lay it on the card, then wipe clean. Repeat with the second foot, placing it next to the other foot to make the shape of a heart. Finish cleaning the child's feet completely and place the craft in an area to dry.

BLESSING:

Say, "Look at your footprint! May you remember God made you in His image—you are His unique creation! God sees your heart and He loves you so much!"

PLAY: Sensory Bottles

SUPPLIES: Sensory bottle

DIRECTIONS:

Find a space on the floor for the child to sit (or have them sit on your lap). ncourage the child to roll the sensory bottle and explore the various objects they see inside. If the child is older, encourage them to identify the objects they recognize in the bottle.

SAY:

Do you see the moon or the stars? God created them just like He created me and you. God knows everything about you. He sees your heart and He loves you SO much!

PLAY: David's Heart

SUPPLIES: Soft hearts

DIRECTIONS:

Find a space on the floor for the child to sit (or have them sit on your lap). Let the baby touch and explore the soft heart with their hands. You can place it gently in their palm or move it near their hand to encourage grasping and exploring the item.

SAY:

David did not look like a king but God saw David's heart. David loved God very much and God loved David too. God sees our heart and God loves us!
