### LESSON GOAL:

For kids to understand that God made everything!

### STORY:

See What God Made!  
by Kathleen Long Bostrom

Read the board book provided in your curriculum bag

### KEY VERSE:

In the beginning, God created the heavens and the earth.

**GENESIS 1:1 (NIRV)**

### WORSHIP

Introduce the value of singing and praising God by singing these songs together or over the kids in your class.



#### SAY:

God is worthy of our praise! Let's sing and dance and praise Him together!



#### DO:

Use instruments or simple hand motions to help kids engage further.

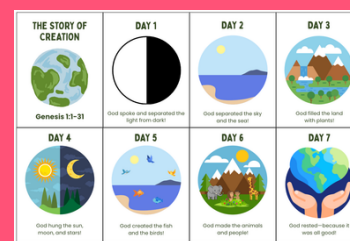


### MAKE: Story of Creation Cards

Help enforce the lesson in a tangible way by helping create this meaningful craft

#### SUPPLIES:

- Creation cards (per child)
- 1 hole punch
- 1 binder ring



#### DIRECTIONS:

Before working with each child, use the hole punch to make a hole in the top left corner of each card (set of 8). Find a clear place to sit with the child and show them each card. Talk about the items God made on each card as you help them place the cards onto the binder ring. Once all the cards are on the ring, close the binder ring to secure the cards. Place the completed set in the child's diaper bag or with their items to take home.

#### PLAY & SAY:

Say, "When you look around, may you remember that God made everything you see!"



### ACTIVITY:

God Made It!

**SUPPLIES:** Variety of items that represent God's creation

#### DIRECTIONS:

Sit on the floor with one child or a group of children. Pull out the items one at a time and talk about what the item is and how God made it. Allow kids to hold and explore the items with supervision.

#### SAY:

"God made everything! Everything God made is good, including you!"



### ACTIVITY:

Animal Sounds

**SUPPLIES:** Images of animals

#### DIRECTIONS:

Hold up an image of an animal and ask the kids what the animal is called. Then ask the kids what sound the animal makes while you make the sound with them.

#### SAY:

"God made the animals we see and hear! God made everything!"
