>>>> AUGUST 1 & 2 <<<<

LESSON TOPIC: The Lord's Prayer**PASSAGE:** Luke 11:1-4

LESSON GOAL: For kids to understand that Jesus is our example of how we can talk to God. While we are not limited to only praying in this one specific way, Jesus gives us an example prayer we can follow to help us center our hearts on God.

GOD STATEMENT: Jesus is Our Example

>>>> AUGUST 8 & 9 <<<<

LESSON TOPIC: The Ten Lepers**PASSAGE:** Luke 17:11-19

LESSON GOAL: For kids to understand that Jesus is worthy of praise simply because of who He is and what He's done for us! Jesus died on the cross and saved us from our sins. That, alone, is worthy of our praise!

GOD STATEMENT: Jesus is Worthy of Praise

>>>> AUGUST 15 & 16 <<<<

LESSON TOPIC: The Good Shepherd**PASSAGE:** John 10:7-18

LESSON GOAL: For kids to understand that Jesus is our protector, guide, and Savior who loves us completely, just like a shepherd looks after his sheep.

GOD STATEMENT: Jesus is Our Shepherd

LESSON TOPIC: Jesus Welcomes the Little Children**PASSAGE:** Matthew 19:13-15

LESSON GOAL: For kids to understand that Jesus loves and values them, and that they can come to Him with trust and faith..

GOD STATEMENT: Jesus is Our Friend

>>>> August 29 & 30 <<<<

LESSON TOPIC: I am the Vine: Remember & Celebrate**PASSAGE:** John 15:1-17

LESSON GOAL: For kids to spend time reflecting on and celebrating the ways God has grown us over this past season!

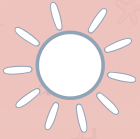
GOD STATEMENT: God Grows us

DIG DEEPER AT HOME



IN THE MORNING:

Before everyone heads out for the day, have each family member say one intentional way you will choose to **connect with Jesus** that day.

Examples: "Today I will pray before I go to sleep" or "Today I will read my Bible for 20 minutes."



IN THE CAR:

Play a special version of "I Spy" called **"I Spy God's Awesome Creation!"** Take turns spotting something outside while riding in the car and saying, "I spy..."! Then name what you see—like trees, clouds, animals, or mountains. To make it extra fun, say your answers in a silly voice, whisper, or even shout them out!



DURING DINNER:

While sitting around the dinner table, go around and have each person finish the sentence: **"Today I noticed God's goodness when..."** This is a great way to reflect on the day—whether it was easy or hard—and to help children recognize God's presence in everyday moments.



IN THE EVENING:

High Five Prayer - Give your child a high-five, then have each person pray and thank God for one thing per finger:

- **Thumb:** Something you love
- **Pointer:** Someone you care about
- **Middle:** Something big God did
- **Ring:** A promise God keeps
- **Pinky:** Something you're thankful for

ACTIVITY FOR LITTLES THANK YOU HUNT



DIRECTIONS: Walk around the room with your child(ren) and take turns finding things God has given us. Point to each item and say, "Thank You, God, for ____!"

CONNECTION: "We can praise God for all the good things He has given us. He loves us and cares for us every day!"
