LESSON GOAL:

For kids to understand that God is good all the time. Even when life is hard or things don't feel good, God is still good.

STORY:

God is Good All the Time
by Margi McCombs

*Read the book provided
in the curriculum bag*

KEY VERSE:

*Taste and see that
the Lord is good.
Blessed is the
person who goes to
him for safety.*

Psalms 34:8 (NIRV)



WORSHIP

*Introduce the value of singing and praising
God by singing these songs together or
over the kids in your class.*



SAY:

God is worthy of our praise! Let's
sing and dance and praise Him
together!



DO:

Use instruments or simple hand
motions to help kids engage further.

MAKE: Ice Cream Bar Photo Magnet

Help enforce the lesson in a tangible way by helping create this meaningful craft

SUPPLIES:

- Ice cream bar craft kit
- Verse sticker
- Instant print camera



DIRECTIONS:

Find a clear space to work with each child individually and prepare all your materials before you begin. Take a picture of the child using the instant print camera provided. Then, assemble the ice cream bar treat using the craft kit provided. Adhere the child's picture onto the ice cream bar. Last, add the "Taste & see the Lord is good" verse sticker.

Place the craft in a safe place (out of reach from children) until parents come to pick up.

SAY:

"Taste and see that the Lord is good!"



ACTIVITY:

**God is Good All the Time
Clock Activity**

SUPPLIES: *Cardboard clock with
images of people/places*

DIRECTIONS:

Sit on the floor with one child or a group of children. Let the child explore the clock hands gently. Help the child move the clock hands to different images as you talk about how God is good all the time.

SAY:

When we are at home,
God is good! When we are
in the car, God is good!
When we are happy, God
is good! Even when we are
sad, God is still good! God
is good all the time!



ACTIVITY:

Good Things

SUPPLIES: *Bag of objects that
represent God's good gifts*

DIRECTIONS:

Gather the children in a circle with the bag. Pull out one item at a time and let kids explore it. Talk about each item and how it represents God's goodness (example: an apple represents the good food God gives us). As you pull each item out, say, "Thank you, God! You are good!"

SAY:

"God is good, and He
gives us good gifts
because He loves us."
