

MAKE: "Walking on Water" Footprint Craft

Help each baby create a memorable craft for a loved one

SUPPLIES:

- Card
- White stamp pad or paint



DIRECTIONS:

Gently press the baby's first foot onto the stamp pad or brush paint on foot. Help them step carefully onto the paper in the middle of the water image. Wipe their foot clean immediately with a damp cloth. Repeat with the other foot. Set the paper aside to dry.

BLESSING:

Say, "Look at your footprints on the water. Peter had to have faith to walk towards Jesus. Jesus wants us to walk in faith towards Him, too!"

PLAY: Stepping in Faith

SUPPLIES: Velcro shaped feet , blue or green play scarf

DIRECTIONS:

Lay out velcro "feet" in a path across the floor and use a blue play scarf to represent water. Guide each child gently as they step from one foot to the next, pretending to walk on water. Wave or move the scarf around their feet as they go.

SAY:

"Peter stepped out onto the water because he trusted Jesus. Jesus wants us to trust Him too!"

PLAY: Walking To Jesus

SUPPLIES: Jesus plush

DIRECTIONS:

Stand a short distance away from the child and hold out the Jesus plush. Encourage them to crawl or step toward the plush as if they're walking in faith towards him. Praise each step they take: "You're getting closer!"

SAY:

"Jesus is awesome and He has the power to do amazing things! Jesus wants you to walk in faith towards Him, just like you're walking to this Jesus plush right now."
