### MARCH 2 & 3

FURNACE OF FIRE  
(DANIEL 3)

**BIG IDEA:** God was with three men in the fiery furnace. They trusted that God was the one true God, refused to worship anyone else, and when thrown into the fire, God was with them. God is with us as we walk through our lives, too.

### MARCH 9 & 10

DANIEL & THE LION'S DEN  
(DANIEL 6)

**BIG IDEA:** Daniel served the king, but he refused to do anything that disobeyed God. Because of this, Daniel was thrown into the lion's den, but God was with Daniel in the lion's den and closed the lion's mouths.

### MARCH 16 & 17

THE STORY OF ESTHER  
(ESTHER 1-10)

**BIG IDEA:** Esther was someone unexpected that God used as a part of His plan to rescue His people. This was all part of God's plan to rescue us by sending His Son to save us!

### MARCH 23 & 24 / 30 & 31

PALM SUNDAY / JESUS' RESURRECTION

(MATT. 21:1-11, MARK 11:1-11, LUKE 19:28-44, JOHN 12:12-19 / MATTHEW 27-28)

**BIG IDEA:** The people of Jerusalem worshipped Jesus and shouted "Hosanna!" as he entered the city. He was welcomed as a king. A short time later, the same people chose to crucify Him and He died. Three days later, He rose again! Believing in His death and resurrection is the only way to eternal life. He has saved us!
