Galatians 5:13-18

God Statement: God is the One True God

KEY VERSE: "Remember what happened in the past. Think about what took place long ago. I am God. There is no other God. I am God. There is no one like me."

(Isaiah 46:9, NIRV)

CHECK-IN

Classroom Teacher
(until 15 minutes after the start of each service)

As kids check-in, please have them wash their hands or use hand sanitizer before entering your classroom. Then they can participate in the various activities and games in your classroom. 10 minutes after the start of your service time, ask the kids to clean up their activities and toys so you can begin the Explore Activity at 15 minutes after the start of service.

OPENING FREE TIME ACTIVITY

MISSION FOCUS – TEACHER APPRECIATION BAGS:

As part of our current mission focus, kids can decorate bags during the opening free time prior to starting the explore activity.

Supplies: white paper bags, stickers, markers, crayons

Directions: Encourage kids to decorate a bag for teachers around our city. They can write an encouraging note, put a funny joke, or draw a picture. This is an optional activity for kids as they arrive, so kids are welcome to do more than one bag.

Say: Remember how we talked about teachers last week for our mission focus? Well, these are the special bags that we get to decorate for teachers. They will be filled with goodies and treats to encourage teachers for all their hard work. This is one way we can show love to others!

EXPLORE ACTIVITY

Classroom Teacher (15 minutes)

The Explore Activity is a chance to get the kids thinking about the upcoming Bible story for the day. Encourage your kids to engage with the activity as they prepare for the lesson.

DISCUSS: God is Love

In today's lesson, we are going to learn about how God is Love!

SAY:

We've been learning how God is the one true God. Let's say that together. What does that mean? *Let kids respond.* Those are all great ideas. It means that there is no other like our God – He is the only God and His Word is true. Today, we're going to see another example of why God is the one true God, and that is God is love!

What do you think of when you hear the word love? *Let kids respond – i.e. hearts, kindness, friendship, hugs, family, etc.* Those are all great ideas. Love is not just a feeling, but an action too! Love is an action like when your brother/sister is sad and you give them your toy to cheer them up – that's love. Or when you get hurt outside and your grownup cleans up your ouchie and gives you a hug – that's love. But do you know what the greatest love of all is? That Jesus died on the Cross and rose again for you and for me... Because He loves us!

God is love! God loves us so much, and He wants us to share that love with others! We can love others because God loves us. Let's do this activity and think more about how we can love others.

MAKE:

To get the kids thinking about the lesson, they can do this activity!

Love Your Neighbor Coloring Page

Supplies: one coloring page per child

Directions: Pass out coloring page and crayons, etc. for kids to color. This can also be sent home if there is not enough time in class to complete.

Say: Today we get to learn about something very important! We get to learn about loving one another! God calls us to love each other, as we love ourselves. Before we start our lesson, let's color a special poster!

LARGE GROUP

(25 minutes)

Each week, Large Group will consist of an introduction, worship, the Bible lesson, worship response, and the blessing.

WELCOME & EXPECTATIONS

Host

Depending on your age group, either find a designated space in your classroom or join the other classes for Large Group in the specified location.

As children enter into Large Group time, welcome and greet the children, telling them you're excited to have them joining this evening/morning.

Expectations Slide

Once everyone has found their seat, the host will use the Large Group expectations slide to go over the rules. Encourage various children to take turns reading the rules.

*** After Expectations, transition the power point to the "Worship" slide. ***

KEY VERSE

Host

Before you start worship, introduce/review the key Bible verse for the quarter. This is a great opportunity for you to talk about the importance of God's Word and encourage the kids to work on memorizing the verse each week.

Use the Key Verse Motions Video on Plex (or sent in weekly email) to learn the motions prior to Large Group.

"Remember what happened in the past. Think about what took place long ago. I am God. There is no one like me."

(Isaiah 46:9, NIRV)

*** After the Introduction, transition the power point to the Worship songs and invite the Worship Leader up front to lead the kids in worship.***

OPENING WORSHIP

Worship Leader

While the video is playing the opening worship songs, encourage the kids to sing and dance along. Don't forget to set the example by participating alongside them!

Kids may participate in the worship however they feel led. Encourage kids to find a way that helps them worship best but remind them that it's not time to goof off or talk to friends. If you have someone leading the worship up front, you can even invite a few kids to help.

TODAY'S WORSHIP SONGS:

- Less Like Me
- Real Love
- Closing: Same God

*** After Worship, transition the power point into the Bible Story video where the kids will hear about the lesson for the day.***

BIBLE STORY

Lesson Video

Remind the group before starting the video to follow the expectations for Large Group.

THIS WEEK'S LESSON: God is Love – We Serve Others Because We Love

Encourage kids to listen and engage with the lesson as they watch the teaching video.

After the video finishes, turn on soft worship music (with or without lyrics) to transition into Worship Response. This should be background music to help set the tone for a quiet reflection time with God.

WORSHIP RESPONSE

Host

Worship Response is an opportunity for the kids to apply what they just learned and to respond to what God is doing in their life. *Have the kids sit in a place where they can be still and reflect independently.* Then read through the Worship Response prompts below as you lead the kids through the time.

Supplies: Serving cards, markers/pens

I have a question for you – who does God tell us to love? *Let kids respond – our neighbors, everyone, all people.* God tells us to love our neighbors as ourselves, but when He says neighbors, does He just mean the people right next door to us? No! He means everyone!

Last week, we learned that God uses the Holy Spirit to bring us all together, and today, we learned that the Holy Spirit also helps us to love everyone! Does that mean I even have to love that kid at school who wasn't nice to me? Or my brother after he steals my toys? Or the new kid I haven't met? Yes! God is love and He wants us to show others His love, and that means everyone!

SERVE IN LOVE CARDS ACTIVITY:

One way we can show love is through our actions. Sometimes we call it serving. When we serve someone, we put their needs or wants ahead of our own. Like if we really want to eat the last cookie after dinner, but instead we serve our brother/sister by giving them the last cookie - that is love!

In a minute, you are going to get a chance to pick a card off the board with a way you can serve someone in love this week. When you grab a card, go back to your seat and on the back, draw yourself doing that act of service.

Release kids by class/group to pick a card. Remind them to wait quietly for their teachers to read the card. Then, allow kids to take a few minutes to draw themselves on the other side of the card. Once everyone is finished, gather back together and say:

Now that you have a special card to remind you, your challenge is to take it home and try to do that act of service! And when you come back next week, tell your teachers how it went.

God is love and He wants us to share His love with everyone. Let's thank God for His love!

Close in prayer.

After Worship Response, transition the power point to the closing Worship videos and invite the Worship Leader to come back up.

CLOSING WORSHIP

Worship Leader

Play the closing worship song included in the power point and encourage the kids to sing and praise along.

This closing song is intended to be a transition for the kids to finish processing and reflecting on the lesson before transitioning to the small group time.

After Worship or Bible Story, transition the power point to the "Compassion International" slide.

COMPASSION & OFFERING

Host

Before closing large group, take a moment to highlight and discuss each campus' Compassion sponsor child. Explain a little about the Compassion child's life and the impact their offering has for this child (info should be provided on cards in classroom). Then remind kids that if anyone brought offering, now is the time to come forward to donate.

Ask a child to come up and pray for the offering and their Compassion child.

After Compassion & Offering, transition the power point to the "Announcement" slide. The host will discuss any current announcements.

ANNOUNCEMENTS & SPECIAL MISSIONS FOCUS – Teacher Appreciation Bags Host

Take this opportunity to cover any announcements and special missions focus for the kids, such as upcoming events or reminders, like bringing food donations for Feeding Families. Use the slides provided in the Power Point to display important announcements.

Raise your hand if you are excited that school is almost over. Raise your hand if you are sad that school is almost over. Well, as we wrap up the school year, we have a mission focus to get ready for next year!

Does anyone remember the paper bags we decorated last August for teachers in our schools? *Let kids respond.* If you decorated one of these bags in your classroom today, raise your hand. These bags are a special way to love and thank teachers for all they do for us. Would we be able to learn without our teachers? No! Teachers do so much for us, and we want to do something kind for them to show them Jesus' love.

Invite a couple kids to come up and pray for teachers to finish the school year strong and for the bags that will be decorated next week to celebrate teachers.

***After Announcements, transition the power point to the "Blessing" slide. The host will lead the class in receiving the blessing for the day. ***

BLESSING

Host

Read the verse and blessing over the kids before closing Large Group. Encourage the kids to stand and open their hands to receive the blessing as a truth that they can take with them this week and hide in their hearts.

May you know that God loves you. May you find a way to show God's love to someone else this week!

SMALL GROUP

Classroom Teachers (10 minutes)

Younger Kids:

This time is optional for younger kids, depending on if you feel like the kids are still listening and participating well.

- 1. What did you learn about God from our story today?
- 2. Read/ Recap today's story: Galatians 5:13-18
 - a. **How should we treat others?** (We should love them as ourselves. We should be kind to them)
 - b. What does God give us to help us live for Him and be more like Him? (The Holy Spirit)
 - c. Should we treat others harshly and mean? (No!)
- 3. We should show proof that we are followers of Christ, by treating others kindly and with love. We should love one another! What is one way you can show love or kindness to someone else?

Close small group in prayer.

Older Kids:

Encourage the kids to utilize their personal Bibles or the classroom Bibles to read the Scripture as a group.

- 1. What did you learn about God from our story today?
- 2. Read scripture: Galatians 5:13-14
 - a. **How should we treat others?** (We should love them as ourselves. We should be kind to them.)
- 3. Read scripture: Galatians 5: 16-18
 - a. What does God give us to help us live for Him and be more like Him? (The Holy Spirit)
 - b. Should we treat others harshly and mean? (No!)
- 4. We should show proof that we are followers of Christ, by treating others kindly and with love. We should love one another! What is one way you can show love or kindness to someone else?

Close small group in prayer.

RESPOND ACTIVITY

Classroom Teacher (10 minutes)

DISCUSS:

If you have extra time at the end of your lesson and small group time, the kids can participate in this activity.

PLAY: Toss the Heart!

Supplies: one squish heart, music on Plex/Spotify in classroom

Directions: Have children stand in a circle. Take turns tossing the heart from child to child, while the music plays. Pause the music and have the children freeze when the music stops. When the music stops, the child that catches the heart can share something they love about someone they know or have them share one way they love someone else. Continue playing until most or all children have had a turn.

Say: We are called to love one another, like Christ loves us. Let's play a special game to share ways we love others.

CHECK-OUT

Classroom Teacher (end of service)

As parents arrive for check-out, the kids can continue participating in the Respond Activities or the classroom games and toys.
