## BABIES & TODDLERS

### FEBRUARY 3 & 4

NAAMAN THE LEPER  
(2 KINGS 5:1-19)

**BIG IDEA:** Naaman was an important commander of an army. He had a disease called leprosy. Elisha told Naaman to wash in the dirty Jordan River seven times. Then, he would be healed. Naaman thought he was too important to do this, but he did, and he was healed! God can heal our hurts, too.

### FEBRUARY 10 & 11

JEREMIAH THE PROPHET  
(JEREMIAH 38)

**BIG IDEA:** Jeremiah spoke God's words to His people, the Israelites. They didn't want to listen to Jeremiah, so they put Jeremiah into a muddy dungeon. God provided a man to beg for Jeremiah to be rescued and he was. God is trustworthy even when the world is against us!

### FEBRUARY 17 & 18

DANIEL TRAINED IN BABYLON  
(DANIEL 1)

**BIG IDEA:** Daniel asked to eat only vegetables while at the king's palace because he was not allowed to eat some of the foods he was offered. After ten days, Daniel was stronger than any of the other men! God was faithful and helped Daniel because Daniel followed His directions.

### FEBRUARY 24 & 25

DANIEL INTERPRETS KING NEBUCHADNEZZAR'S DREAM  
(DANIEL 2)

**BIG IDEA:** The king had terrible dreams. No one could tell him what they meant. God told Daniel what they meant and Daniel told the king. Daniel was given more power in the kingdom. God gave Daniel wisdom to know what the king's dreams meant. God gives us wisdom because he cares for us.
