JANUARY 6 & 7

JOHN THE BAPTIST (MATTHEW 3)

BIG IDEA: John the Baptist's job was to prepare the people for Jesus' ministry. He wanted the people to stop sinning and turn to God for help. God prepared the people's hearts for Jesus and He prepares our hearts for the things that happen in our lives, too.

GOD PREPARES OUR HEART

JANUARY 20 & 21

DAVID BECOMES KING (1 SAMUEL 16 & 17, 2 SAMUEL 5)

BIG IDEA: God protected David and kept him safe from King Saul because David was going to be the next king of Israel. God knew David would be a good king because He could see David's heart was good. God knows us and He sees our hearts!

GOD SEES OUR HEART

JANUARY 13 & 14

DAVID IS ANOINTED AND FIGHTS GOLIATH
(1 SAMUEL 16 & 17)

BIG IDEA: David was a little boy with a big heart!
God gave him courage to fight Goliath, a giant,
with just a sling and a stone. God can do things
that seem impossible to us and help us have
courage when we are afraid.

GOD IS COURAGE

JANUARY 27 & 28

ELIJAH THE PROPHET (1 KINGS 17-2 KINGS 2)

BIG IDEA: Elijah spoke God's words to the Israelites. God showed His power when He made fire come from heaven when Elijah called on Him. He was all powerful then, and He is all powerful now! He is the one true God and can do things we can't imagine.

KEY VERSE: ISAIAH 43:2. NIRV



GOD STATEMENT:God Is With Us



MORNING TIME:

Before the busyness of the day begins, talk about what it means that "God is With Us." Spend some time in conversation sharing about how you see God with you. Put on "God With Us" by Jesus Culture and spend some intentional time praying over your family.





While sitting down and sharing a meal together, take the time to play a fun game of "Once Upon a Time." You will start the game saying, "Once Upon a Time," and then you will take turns going around the table and adding a word to make up a silly story.



CAR TIME:

Riding in the car with your family could be a great time to have a scavenger hunt. Pick a theme, for example, "Things found on Noah's Ark," and take a couple of minutes looking out the window for things you would find in that category.



NIGHTTIME:

While everyone is winding down for the night, turn on a fake fire (or make a real one), gather pillows, blankets, stuffed animals, and flashlights to make a cozy little space. Then dim the lights and open up your Bible to dive into some intentional time in the Word with your family.
