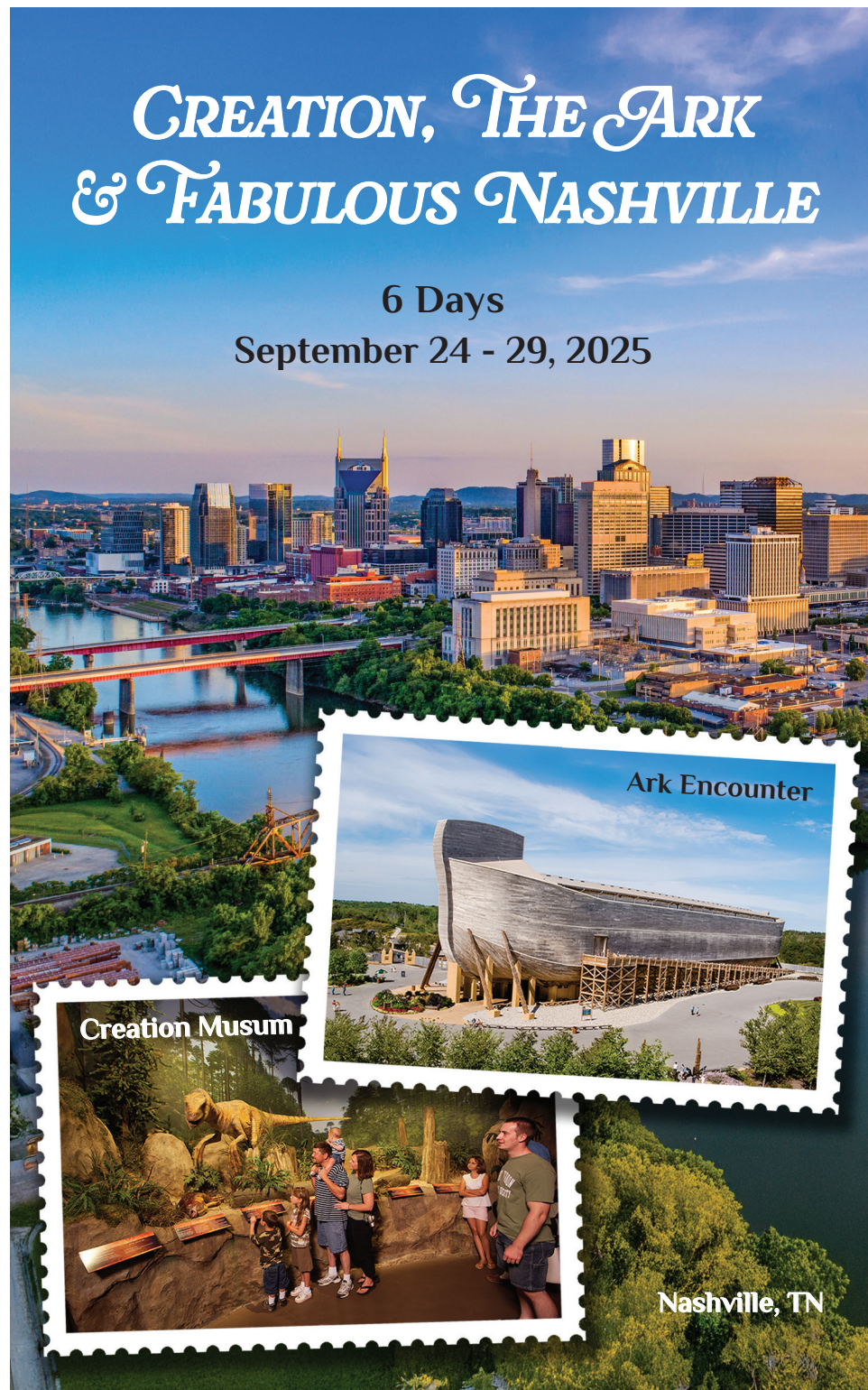

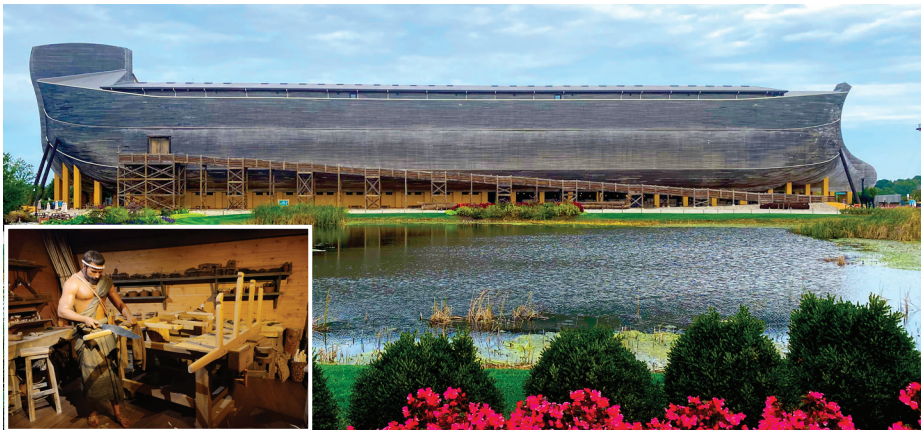

1 FLIGHT • DENVER CO TO CINCINNATI OH: Today we board our flight at Denver International Airport bound for Cincinnati OH where we begin our adventure to the Creation Museum, Ark Encounter and Fabulous Nashville. Upon arrival in Cincinnati, we climb aboard a beautiful Prevost motorcoach and are joined by your Christian Tours tour director. We check into the Drury Inn for a two nights' stay excited about our adventures ahead.

2 CREATION MUSEUM • STARGAZER'S PLANETARIUM • DINNER: It's just a short drive to the state-of-the-art, "Answers in Genesis" Creation Museum. The museum brings the pages of the Bible to life, casting its characters and animals in dynamic form and placing them in familiar settings. You can personally interact with many of the 160 exhibits. Walk through the Garden of Eden, see life-size dinosaurs, and enjoy the Special Effects Theatre. You have time for lunch on your own at the Museum before taking our seats at the Stargazer's Planetarium where we learn about the heavens from a biblical perspective. We have an included dinner together this evening at a local favorite before returning to our hotel. **B D**

3 ARK ENCOUNTER • LUNCH • KENTUCKY HORSE FARM TOUR: Today we have a full day to explore and experience the life-sized Ark. Built according to the dimensions given in the Bible, the Ark Encounter has dozens of exhibits within this unique attraction bringing to life the biblical account of Noah's Ark. We learn how Noah and his family could have fit and cared for the animals on the Ark. Other exhibits showcase what Noah and his world were like before the flood, while others highlight the enormous impact the flood has had on our world. The Answers Center hosts daily presentations with world-class creation



apologetics speakers. You may choose to soar through the air on zip lines (*additional cost*), reaching up to 50 mph and 17 stories high or visit animals from around the world at the Ark Encounter's Ararat Ridge Zoo. Take a break from exploring and enjoy your included lunch at Emzara's Café. Late this afternoon, we travel a short distance south to Lexington, Kentucky where we visit one of Lexington's beautiful horse farms. Learn how these amazing animals are raised and trained to be legends in the racing world. We check into our area hotel this evening. **B L**



4 NASHVILLE • OPRY MILLS LUNCH & SHOPPING • ANDREW JACKSON'S HERMITAGE • OPRYLAND RESORT - 2 NIGHTS • DINNER • GRAND OLE OPRY 100TH BIRTHDAY ANNIVERSARY: This morning we head towards Nashville and the beautiful Gaylord Opryland Resort. Upon arrival we have time for lunch and outlet shopping at Opry Mills. Step into the world of the nation's 7th president, Andrew Jackson, where history comes alive within the walls of his magnificent

house, Hermitage. Uncover the tales of this enigmatic figure as you wander through the rooms that witnessed his larger-than-life personality, making your visit an unforgettable journey into the past. Next, we check-in the Opryland Hotel for a two-night stay. The resort boasts an immense two-acre enclosed European-style garden conservatory. It features more than 6,000 plants and a six story cascading waterfall. We have an included dinner together this evening before we join the thousands of fans from across the country and around the world at the Grand Ole Opry which is celebrating its 100th Birthday in 2025. Appearances are scheduled a week prior so there's no telling who we might see. **B D**

5 NASHVILLE CITY TOUR • GENERAL JACKSON RIVERBOAT SHOW & LUNCH CRUISE • OPRYLAND RESORT: This morning we join our local Nashville guide and tour the capital city and home to country music. The tour includes a ride by the State Capitol Building, the Parthenon, and Music Row to see the recording studios where the stars of yesterday and today record their hit songs. Next we board the General Jackson, grandest showboat of them all. The authentic paddle wheeler was designed to recreate the showboats that plied the waters of American rivers in the 19th century. We enjoy a fabulous lunch, entertainment and a 2-hour cruise on the Cumberland River. We have the afternoon and evening free for you to explore the Opryland Resort. **B L**

6 COUNTRY MUSIC HALL OF FAME • DOWNTOWN EXPLORING • FLIGHT HOME: This morning we visit the Country Music Hall of Fame.
