As valued team members, both roles also receive intentional, caring support and guidance as they engage with coaches and mentors, participate in weekly leadership classes, offer and receive direct feedback and dedicate time to investing in and deepening their relationship with God through the program!

## **JOB FUNCTION**

- 1. Assists in all Access Ministry programs, staffing and events on all campuses (including adults with disabilities, summer day camp, weekend services, special events)
- 2. Build community with Access caregivers, guardians, and families
- 3. Modify curriculum for participants
- 4. Collaborate in weekly team meetings with Woodmen Kids staff
- 5. Administrative tasks throughout the week (family phone calls, sending out emails,
- 6. gathering supplies)
- 7. Develop and implement activities and opportunities for spiritual growth in each student; find/create serving opportunities for participants and their families
- 8. Assist in the development, training, and support of Access MPs
- 9. Manage programming during weekend services (observing students, offering suggestions for working with students, assisting in behaviors, filling in as a substitute teacher or shadow, etc.)
