


- 4 BRANSON SCENIC RAILWAY • DUTTON’S • CABARET MAGIC DINNER SHOW:** We board the Branson Scenic Railway in coach class aboard vintage rail-cars for a scenic ride through the beautiful Ozarks, then we enjoy The Duttons’ dynamic family performance. We end at the Cabaret Magic Dinner Show that combines a delicious meal with up-close magic, comedy, and illusion. You’ll laugh, you’ll be amazed, and you might even become part of the show! **D**
- 5 CLAY COOPER’S COUNTRY MUSIC EXPRESS • BRANSON CRAFT MALL • LUNCH – PICKIN’ PORCH DELI • DAVID AT SIGHT & SOUND THEATRE:** Today we enjoy Clay Cooper’s high-energy, patriotic show, browse the Craft Mall, and savor lunch at Pickin’ Porch Deli. This afternoon, we experience a breathtaking biblical production of “David” at Sight & Sound Theatres—an epic biblical story brought to life with massive sets, live animals, sweeping music, and powerful storytelling that brings Scripture to life in unforgettable ways. **L**
- 6 SILVER DOLLAR CITY:** Experience the delights of autumn as the Ozark hills come alive in this 1880s-style Ozark village City with color, pumpkins galore, classic fall flavors, lots of craftsmen demonstrating traditional skills, live entertainment throughout and attractions for those young at heart.
- 7 COLLEGE OF THE OZARKS • RALPH FOSTER MUSEUM • BRANSON BELLE DINNER CRUISE:** We tour College of the Ozarks, where students work in exchange for their education, followed by a stop at the Ralph Foster Museum, the “Smithsonian of the Ozarks.” Then we enjoy free time in downtown Branson to shop, snack, or explore. Tonight, we set sail on the Showboat Branson Belle, an authentic paddle-wheeler for a 3-course dinner cruise featuring stunning views, musical entertainment, and classic Americana vibes. **D**
- 8 FANTASTIC CAVERNS • DINNER:** We leave Branson and begin the journey home—but not before stopping at America’s only ride-through cave! We board a tram and journey underground to see dramatic formations and learn about the cave’s unique history — from ancient geology to Prohibition-era secrets. After a quick lunch stop, we enjoy another included dinner and rest for the night in Pratt, Kansas. **D**
- 9 DODGE CITY • BOOT HILL MUSEUM • PHOTO STOP – DOC HOLLIDAY • HOME:** Our final day takes us to the Old West in Dodge City at Boot Hill Museum! This immersive museum recreates the frontier days with historic buildings, cowboy artifacts, gunfights (reenacted!), and saloon-style fun. A must-see for any history or Western movie fan.
